



“New-Normal” - Freestyle Rules

- Social distancing 6 feet apart must be followed in all areas of the entire facility.
- If skaters experienced any symptoms of Covid-19 or had any contacts with person who have contracted with virus immediately report to Skating Director and quarantine at home for 14 days.
- Maximum number of skaters allowed 12 per one-hour or 40-min sessions.
- Skaters must bring minimum belongs to the rink side: water bottle and tissues will be allowed. *Preferably bring small tissue box & water bottle to place on the boards around the rink.*
- All skaters MUST use designated garbage can on the rink side for used tissues.
- Maximum one parents/adult per skater in the facility and preferably only one sibling.
- Coaches MUST wear masks while teaching during freestyle sessions.
- Skaters and parents could wear masks, but it would not be required, social distancing is a key!
- Coaches may have an option to teach from the rink side or on the ice based on the lesson plan.
- Coaches must follow 6-foot social distance guidelines if teaching on the ice to demonstrate skill to the skater
- Coaches must refrain any physical contact with students
- All FWISC skaters MUST provide their music program to the Skating Director
- All FWISC skater’s music will recorded on one CD and only coaches will be allowed to play music.
- All view areas must follow 6-feet - social distancing guidelines (on the bleachers or upstairs)
