3. Should injury occur I understand I am still responsible for the monetary commitment that I have made.
4. My Skater will not be absent from more than one rehearsal or they may be excused from their position. Should this occur I understand that I am still responsible for the monetary commitment that I have made.
5. The show director may ask my skater to leave the show should their behavior during the show, rehearsals, or practices be disruptive or unacceptable according to the coaching staff and or FWISC Guidelines.
6. Dress Rehearsal is mandatory and my Skater will attend. (Dress Rehearsal date May 11.)
7. All Skaters Will Participate in the Show Finale.
8. Show rehearsals will be on Saturdays starting in March (schedule attached). Please note: not everybody will be required at every rehearsal. Detailed schedule will be announced when final cast is determined.
9. Costumes are decided by the show director and costume director. Their decisions are final.
10. FWISC tries to keep all costs as low as possible for the skaters to participate in the show and still present a quality production.
